



# MIRA - Milestones for Data Collection

Milestone	Focus	Frequency
Initial Survey	Consent, household Registration, fixed infrastructures ("baseline")	One-off at baseline
Tracking & Shocks	Shocks, Early Warning Indicators, Migration	Monthly
Coping Strategies	Reduced Coping Strategies Index (RCSI) and HHS strategies	Monthly
Dietary Diversity	Food patterns and food list	Monthly
Off Farm and Wages	Income sources, non-farm enterprise, wage employment and day labor	Quarterly
On-farm	Land ownership, crops, trainings, livestock husbandry, group participation,	Quarterly
Financial and assets	Credit, savings, insurance, assets	Quarterly
WASH	Water sources, sanitation	Semi-annual
