Background

PRO-WASH & SCALE (Practices, Research, and Operations in Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene and Strengthening Capacity in Agriculture, Livelihoods, and Environment) is an Associate Award funded by the USAID Bureau for Humanitarian Assistance (BHA). The purpose of PRO-WASH & SCALE is to strengthen the design, coordination, implementation, and overall effectiveness of key sector-specific interventions across BHA's food and nutrition security portfolio in emergency, early recovery, risk reduction, and resilience (ER4) activities. The Award's technical intervention areas include WASH, agriculture, livelihoods, markets, infrastructure, natural and water resource management, climate change, and disaster risk reduction. The Purpose areas are as follows:

Purpose 1: Capacity Strengthening and Localization,

Purpose 2: Applied Research, Adaptation, and Knowledge Management, and

Purpose 3: Coordination and Collaboration.

PRO-WASH & SCALE is developing a short course on human-centered design for water, sanitation, and hygiene, based on the <u>HCD for WASH: Resource Platform</u>. This short course will be delivered live remotely over a virtual platform such as Microsoft

Teams or Zoom and is anticipated to be a total of 8 hours of live instruction and 8 hours of office hours, spread over 2-3 months. It is estimated that a maximum of 20-25 participants will be enrolled in the session

We are seeking to hire a **Francophone consultant** to support the preparations and pilot testing of this remote short-course. The consultant will be responsible for working closely with the WASH Research and Learning Advisor, the Communications and Knowledge Management Advisor, and partners to develop, organize, pilot test the course for Francophone partners.

Main activities for this consultancy

The consultant will be responsible for:

- Working with the WASH Research and Learning advisor to prepare and analyze learning needs assessments of Francophone partners to inform the short course.
- Adapting an English version of the short course (under development) and resources available here (<u>HCD for WASH: Resource Platform</u>) to prepare for the online short course on human-centered design for WASH in French.
- Identifying/sourcing HCD in WASH case examples relevant to Francophone partners.
- Providing quality assurance for course materials translated into French, such as PPTs, participant exercises, participant surveys, agendas etc.
- Leading the online facilitation of the short course in French, using participatory methods.
- Providing 1-1 support in French to partners during office hours alongside the WASH Research and Learning Advisor to troubleshoot challenges partners face in their own work.
- Reporting on key takeaways from the short course, number of participants, recommendations for future short courses, and next steps.
