


Some KM and Learning and Challenges



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ACDI/VOCA Engagement Strategies – Success


- Learning Champions (LCs)
 - One for each project
 - Learning Champion community
 - Once a month live meeting through Adobe Connect/Skype for Business
- Role of LC
 - Communicate with Staff Learning and Development (SLD) team
 - Learn about ACDI/VOCA systems and available resources
 - Help motivate project staff to use it/provide on site assistance
 - Participate in yearly Learning Champion Challenge

World Vision's Case

Challenge 1: Silos in a large, global and very diverse organization "Oh my, we are too complicated and all over the place!"




- 1. Create smaller groups with roles to promote ownership/autonomy
- 2. Keep groups open, inclusive and interlinked
- 3. BALANCE the two approaches and coordinate

World Vision's Case

Challenge 2: Learning & sharing deprioritized

"Who has time to learn?"



- 1. "But it's FUN!"
- 2. "It takes exactly 15 minutes and can save you 5 hours"
- 3. "It is your responsibility and required by your Job Description/ToR"

World Vision's Case

- Challenge 3: KM budget constraints
 - "We barely have enough \$\$ to implement the project well"



- 1. Start tracking. Start small and build a case for Value for Money
- 2. Leverage e-learning
- 3. Use free or cost-effective tools (there are many!)
