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




Keep It Real

Best Practices

Taking a Systems Approach

Address supply and demand within entire food system

Working with private sector, government, financial institutions, etc.

-) Enabling environment
-) Informal norms







If youth are enabled to take advantage of profitable supply and demand opportunities along agriculture market chains,

and are recognized as key actors by agriculture stakeholders,

then they will be more likely to aspire to work in agricultural value chains, access entry points along those chains (on farm and off farm), and build sustainable livelihoods.




