Workshop Purpose

- Refine the activity design and implementation approaches based on the learnings from various studies, the
 insights provided by stakeholder analysis and consultations, including collaboration with key RISE and other
 non-FFP stakeholders.
- Identify remaining knowledge gaps and develop initial plans for continued learning, knowledge sharing, and activity adaptation beyond the refinement year.
- Address any outstanding PREP questions.

- Collaborative USAID-IP workshop proceedings form the basis for revised TOC and implementation plan submissions.
- It is the IP's responsibility to transform workshop proceedings into fully revised TOC and implementation plan deliverables.
